

GROUP LISTENING PRAYER GUIDE



As part of our annual leadership discernment process, we request that each group meeting within Central's community dedicates one gathering between January 1 and February 15 to listen to Jesus' direction for our church. Please submit a summary of what you heard by February 15.

SUGGESTED FORMAT (75-90 MINUTES):

Identify a facilitator and recorder. Designate one person to lead the group throughout the night and another to record the discussion, submitting it through the QR code provided.

Brief Devotional (7 minutes): The facilitator begins with a short devotional on the power of prayer. Keep it brief as our focus is on listening to God and praying! Need a suggestion for a passage? Check out Matthew 7:7-11, Luke 18:1-8; John 10:14-16; James 5:13-18; 1 John 5:14-15.

Instructions (2 min): The facilitator shares the plan.

Opening Prayer (5 minutes): Have 2-3 people offer a brief opening prayer, inviting Jesus to speak and asking Him to soften our hearts to hear.

Listening Time (15-30 minutes): Sit quietly. Each person takes time to ask, "Jesus, what do you want to say for our church?" It is strongly recommended for each person to bring a Bible, journal, and pen/pencil to record what they hear during this time.

Sharing Time (30 minutes): Each person shares a 2-minute version of what they heard, and the recorder takes notes. Encourage each person to identify a word (or two) summarizing what they heard.

Prayer Time (15 minutes): Take some time at the end to pray together as a group. Thank God for what He is speaking and pray into the recurring themes among the group.

Submit Results: Later that day, the recorder submits a summary of what was heard using the QR code provided.
